### Gettysburg Battlefield Bus Tour with Certified Guide

Two-hour plus tour of the Gettysburg battlefield featuring comfortable transportation, multiple stops, and informative presentations by a licensed and certified guide. The bus will pick up and drop off our tour group at the Gettysburg Wyndham Hotel. Cost (\$40 per person) includes bus ticket and gratuities for the driver and guide. Gather at the hotel entrance at 1:30pm.

### Gettysburg Battle Focused Tour with Allen Knechtmann, US Army Historian

MOSB member Allen Knechtmann, a US Army historian assigned to Carlisle Barracks, PA, will conduct a focused look at Day One events of the Battle of Gettysburg. This is a free event, but space is limited. Gather in the hotel lobby at 1:45pm.

### Beyond the Battle Museum and Shriver House Tours

A fascinating look at how the war and the 3-day Battle of Gettysburg impacted the townspeople, local businesses and farms. You will visit the museum and beautifully restored Shriver House operated by the Adams County Historical Society. Cost (\$25 per person) includes admission to the award-winning Beyond Battle Museum and a docent-led tour of a prominent Gettysburg family 4-level home. The museum and Shriver House are approximately one mile apart. Carpooling is advised. Expect up to one hour at each site.

### Friday Evening Cracker Barrel at Battlefield Overlook Event Center

Top off the day's events and tours with beverages and snacks while overlooking the battlefield. Reserve your space with \$30 per person toward food, facility rental and gratuity. Savor cigars and whisky provided by host Chapter 324.

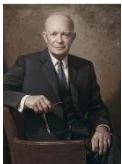
### **Travel Information:**

- The Gettysburg Wyndham is at the intersection of US Highways 15 and 30. Driving time from Harrisburg International Airport is one hour; from Baltimore-Washington, one and a quarter hours.
- Rabbitransit shuttle service runs from the hotel to Gettysburg attractions 8am-9pm daily. A one-person all day pass is \$3.00.

### **Other Gettysburg Area Attractions and Activities**



- Self-guided tour of the Gettysburg National Battlefield. Start at the Visitor Center and obtain materials for a self-guided tour you can complete at your own pace by vehicle, bicycle, or hiking.



- Eisenhower Farm. Visit the home and farm where President Dwight Eisenhower and Mamie Eisenhower spent leisure time and hosted famous and influential persons. The Eisenhower National Historic Site is on Baltimore Pike, phone 717-338-9114.



- Horseback Tours of Gettysburg National Battlefield. Horseback tours offer unique experiences and views of the 1863 battlefield. "Ride Into History" by contacting the National Riding Stables, 610 Taneytown Rd, Gettysburg, PA, phone 717-334-5100. Call to make reservations and learn about height, weight, and other restrictions which apply



- Gettysburg College. Founded in 1832 as Pennsylvania College, the College was a prominent landmark and field hospital during the July 1863 battle. In October 1863, graduate David Wills invited President Lincoln to visit the College and cemetery and "make a few appropriate remarks." Enrollment at Gettysburg College today exceeds 2,000. Visit the campus by following North Washington Street to Pennsylvania Hall Drive.

## **Suggested Gettysburg Restaurants**

Most restaurants are crowded during Summer months. Make reservations when feasible. We tend to frequent the following places when we are in town:

*Dobbin House Tavern (89 Steinwehr Ave) - Simple to elegant dining options in a historic setting. Call ahead 717-334-2100*

*Historic Cashtown Inn (1325 Old Rte 30, 8 miles West of Gettysburg) -Great choice. Served as a Confederate HQs in July 1863. Call ahead 717-334-9722*

*One Lincoln (adj to Hotel Gettysburg on Lincoln Square) - American fare in the center of town*

*Hoss' Steak and Sea (1140 York Rd; family dining near Gettysburg Wyndham)*

*Gettysburg Family Restaurant (near Gettysburg Wyndham in Peeble's Plaza, 1275 York Rd)*
